## Notes:

- Bursaries are granted based on <u>need</u> (ie. the difference between declared expenses and declared resources). If your resources exceed your expenses, you likely won't be considered high need.
- If you have special circumstances that are not reflected in the form, you may include an explanatory letter.
- Bursaries are normally allocated in June. A second round of bursaries will be allocated in the Fall, focused particularly on students who entered the program after the May 31<sup>st</sup> deadline.
- A reserve from the Bursary Fund is maintained each year after distribution for emergency bursaries. Students who are facing extreme financial hardship should contact the principal.
