The LDM is for you! The Leadership Development Module is a great continuing education opportunity. Grounded in an action-reflection model of learning, it can go as deep as you want to take it.

The LDM is for you! The Leadership Development Module is a practical introduction to group facilitation, group planning processes, and conflict resolution. There's lots of work in teams, so you get to integrate your skills and challenge yourself.

The LDM is for you! The Leadership Development Module can be taken as a stand-alone course, but it's also the first step in CCS's diaconal training program and a great way to find out what the Centre for Christian Studies is all about.
