**Where:** The Centre for Christian Studies (CCS) is a theological school training leaders for ministries of justice, compassion, and transformation. Based in Winnipeg, Manitoba, Canada, with roots in both the Anglican Church of Canada and the United Church of Canada, CCS creates an environment of practical learning for transformative ministry. Using an integrated Action/Reflection model and Adult and Learner-Led teaching methods, CCS puts in the centre theologies of liberation and perspectives from under-represented groups.

**Job Description:** Our Program Staff provide education and formation for students preparing for or furthering their education in diaconal ministry, as Deacons and Diaconal Ministers as well as leaders ministering “in a diaconal way.” Our graduates go on to minister in faith communities and in justice - and faith-based organizations.

The highly collaborative community of learning includes Program Staff, the Principal, Administration, Contract Staff, volunteers, and students. Program Staff work both virtually and in person to facilitate student learning through Learning Circles (intensive courses), Field placements, and Assignments.
